

MASSB FOUNDATION'S NEW "LIFTING LIVES" AWARD

Recognition of Innovation and Community Impact

OPEN FOR NOMINATIONS

Deadline: September 30, 2023

MASSB Foundation's Lifting Lives Award has been designed to expand upon the previous Innovative Program Awards. Two categories of nominations within this single award will now be allowed. The first category continues our historic recognition of **innovation**. The second category is for programs that may not be innovative but have made a **significant impact** on the members of your community.

Awarded annually as part of MASSB's annual conference, each local board is invited to nominate a program that is either Innovative or one that is not new but has a significant Impact on your community.

Awards will be ranked by those considered to be most Innovative OR Impactful (is it new, can it be replicated to other counties, was the local board involved in the development or execution of the program, and what is the program's estimated impact to your community).

The award includes a monetary allocation to the winning board's MASSB Foundation account. The award for First Place is \$1,500. Second Place is \$1000, and Third Place is \$500.

To nominate a program, please submit a 1–2-page description, including: families/staff impacted, cost of activity, any resulting cost/time savings, and likelihood for replication. Nominees should be prepared to make a presentation highlighting the program/initiative during the MASSB Annual Conference on October 12-13, 2023.
